<b>Allan Scott Cecilia Brut – Marlborough</b> This Methode has biscuity rich stonefruit characters and a big mouth filling finish.		\$45
<b>Oyster Bay Brut - Marlborough</b> Elegant cool climate varietal intensity - radiant lime, citrus and white peach, accentuated by a finely bubbled palate with a crisp, refreshing finish.		\$52
<b>Piper Heidsieck Cuvee Brut – France</b> Lively and fresh, with more mature notes of pineapple, nutmeg, white pepper and oriental zest.		\$125

<b>Lake Chalice Riesling – Marlborough</b> Delicately bodied and off dry wine with delightful aromas of lime, lemon and grapefruit with a distinct underlying mineral note. Great structure and nicely balanced acidity lead to a lingering finish.	\$9	\$35
<b>Te Whare Ra Riesling ‘D’ – Marlborough</b> Lemon sorbet and ripe grapefruit with hints of beeswax and floral spice are balanced by a fine backbone of ripe acidity.	\$10	\$40
<b>The Ned Pinot Gris – Marlborough</b> Classic pear and nectarine aromas with a full fruit palate of pears, nectarine and peaches. A wonderful fresh, fruit driven palate with a lovely clean dry finish. Great with summer salads, white meats and creamy pastas.	\$9	\$35
<b>Rimu Grove ‘Bronte’ Pinot Gris – Nelson</b> Citrus blossoms, pears, tropical fruit and spice. A firm backbone of minerality and acidity fill the mouth and linger on the palate.		\$46
<b>Jules Taylor Rosé – Marlborough</b> Aromas of strawberries & cream leap out of the glass. Loaded with wonderfully intense raspberry and strawberry flavours.	\$9.5	\$36
<b>Mahi ‘Twin Valleys’ Gewurztraminer – Marlborough</b> The wine is slightly off-dry to balance the acidity. A luscious wine it has great middle palate and length with slight Turkish delight flavours and rose-water overtones.		\$40

<b>Lake Chalice – Marlborough</b> A crisp, medium bodied, dry wine bursting with classical varietal flavours of passion fruit, blackcurrant and gooseberry. And a long, elegant, mineral finish.		\$35
<b>Jules Taylor – Marlborough</b> Rich palate grapefruit flavours again come to the fore. It has a lingering intensity that is very mouth filling, rolling out to a fresh finish.	\$9.5	\$36

<b>Delegat Reserve – Hawke’s Bay</b> On the palate the wine is beautifully layered and textured with weighty, rich tropical fruit and notes of toast and butter, leading to a lingering, seductive finish.	\$9	\$35
<b>Nga Waka – Martinborough</b> Creamy delicious palate with strong peach, melon and nougat flavours. A very smooth wine with a long and elegant finish of ripe citrus fruits.	\$10	\$40
<b>Sacred Hill Halo – Hawke’s Bay</b> Attractive layered aroma with stone fruit supported by floral notes and nuances of hazelnut. The palate is full and very creamy, beautifully textured.		\$44
<b>Rimu Grove – Nelson</b> The palate is fresh, smooth round and generous. A nicely layered wine with elegant sweet nut and toasted oak flavours.		\$48

## pinot noir

<b>Nga Waka Three Paddles – Martinborough</b> A rich, succulent and powerful Martinborough Pinot Noir showing dark berry and spice flavours underpinned by silky tannins and subtle, refined oak from barrel maturation.	\$10.5	\$42
<b>Waipara Hills ‘Southern Cross’ – Central Otago</b> The palate is rich and full with beautifully balanced fruit and smokey oak. Its mouth-filling, silk tannin structure and oak influence add to a persistent finish.		\$49
<b>Mt Difficulty Roaring Meg – Central Otago</b> The wine has a sweet berry entry which displays these same characters in abundance. Tannins rise gracefully out of the mid palate to finish the wine. These are balanced by the wines acidity and fruit, to produce a long fruit driven finish.		\$50
<b>Rockburn – Central Otago</b> Rich, creamy, intense fruits and delicate floral tones enhanced by nuances of wild thyme. Silky tannins leading into a long mocha finish.		\$64

<b>Brookfields ‘Burnfoot’ – Hawke’s Bay</b> Intense in colour, viscous legs cling to the glass. Plum, leather, violets, and sweet berry are manifested on a bed of enriched tannins.	\$8.5	\$34
<b>Lake Chalice – Marlborough</b> A medium bodied Merlot with vibrant fruit and supple tannins, with tones of chocolate and tobacco leaf and underlying spicy, toasty oak.		\$35
<b>Oyster Bay – Hawke’s Bay</b> Ripe plum, berry fruits and hints of spice, accentuated with a nuance of oak and an elegant, lingering soft texture.	\$9.5	\$36

## syrah/shiraz

<b>Nugan Estate 3rd Generation Shiraz – Australia</b> Lifted red berry aromas with spice, ash and earth undertones. A medium bodied wine displaying concentrated sweet berry fruit with spicy, black pepper notes, well integrated oak and supple tannins on the finish.	\$8.5	\$34
<b>Sacred Hill Gimblet Gravels Syrah – Hawke’s Bay</b> The palate is supple with soft, ripe tannins and good length of both texture and flavour.	\$9.5	\$36
<b>Geoff Merrill – McLaren Vale</b> With time in the glass, the wine opens up to reveal a strong peppery/spice note and some mint. The palate is full of lively dark berry fruits, with some chocolate and a savoury soy finish. The tannins are fine and soft, yet offer structure and elegance to the wine.		\$49
<b>Brookfields ‘Hillside’ Syrah – Hawke’s Bay</b> The generous layers of flavours build through the mid-palate and are complemented by integrated oak nuances and velvety tannins. A superb food wine.		\$64

<b>Taylor's Estate – Clare Valley</b>	<b>\$9.5</b>	<b>\$36</b>
<small>This is a wine of great intensity. It has distinctive blackcurrant and cassis fruit flavours. Subtle oak characters of cedar cigar box and spice are also evident. The tannins are fine and elegant, a hallmark of the varietal. The palate is well balanced.</small>		
<b>Geoff Merrill – Coonawarra</b>	<b>\$10.5</b>	<b>\$42</b>
<small>The palate is wonderfully supple and fleshy with fine firm tannins providing excellent structure. Intense flavour, good length and well balanced wine.</small>		
<b>Tatachilla – McLaren Vale</b>		<b>\$52</b>
<small>This is a seamless wine with a dark depth of flavour. Blackcurrant and raspberry fruits are softly rounded by seductive hints of chocolate and nutty oak flavours.</small>		

## red blends

<b>St Hallett Shiraz Grenache – Barossa Valley</b>	<b>\$9</b>	<b>\$35</b>
<small>New World vibrant fresh array of red berry fruits and spice with an underlying old world European earthiness. Finishing with soft yet assertive tannins. This is a very food friendly wine, it interplays rather than dominates.</small>		
<b>Trinity Hill 'The Trinity' – Hawke's Bay</b>	<b>\$9</b>	<b>\$35</b>
<small>Intense &amp; sweet ripe fruit flavours that lead to a lingering finish of blackberry, chocolate and toasty oak.</small>		
<b>Montes Cabernet / Carmenera – Chile</b>		<b>\$40</b>
<small>The well integrated vanilla flavour comes from the oak aging, and adds complexity and elegance. This is a medium to full bodied wine but yet soft and friendly in the palate due to the sweet and firm tannins of the Carmenera component.</small>		
<b>Weeping Sands Cabernet / Merlot – Waiheke</b>		<b>\$48</b>
<small>This is a medium weight wine with both length and breadth of flavour, and a sweet core of fruit in the mid palate. The tannins are bountiful but fine, and they balance beautifully with the wine's soft acidity.</small>

<b>Brookfields Indulgence – Hawke's Bay</b>	<b>\$10.5</b>	<b>\$40</b>
<small>Light straw in colour. Rich and luscious. The palate is packed with ripe apricot and passion fruit.</small>		
<b>Trinity Hill Noble Viognier – Hawke's Bay</b>	<b>\$11</b>	<b>\$48</b>
<small>It is very luscious and concentrated, with strong flavours of dried fruits, especially apricots. The finish is very long and dry with sweetness.</small>		

## ports & sherries

<b>Pykes Cream Sherry</b>	<b>\$6</b>
<small>Extended barrel-maturation has added a delicate complexity and distinctive nutty flavour to this rich, mellow wine.</small>	
<b>Croft Fine Ruby Port</b>	<b>\$9</b>
<small>Matured in cask for an average of three years before bottling. Crisp, full bodied and fruity Port rich in style and with a full deep red, intense appearance.</small>	
<b>Vilagrad Vintage Port</b>	<b>\$10</b>
<small>Harvested from traditional 50 yr old port varieties, this port displays spicy blackcurrant and dark chocolate flavours.</small>	
<b>Quinta de la Rosa Tawny Port</b>	<b>\$10</b>
<small>This Port exhibits a nuttiness and a complexity not often found in these types of tawnies. Good to drink chilled as an aperitif as well as after dinner. This Port has been lightly filtered and does not require decanting.</small>
