Creamy delicious palate with strong peach, melon and nougat flavours. A very smooth wine with a long and elegant finish of ripe citrus fruits.		
Mahi – Marlborough		\$46
A well structured, elegant wine with vibrant, citrus, peachy, slightly nutty flavours showing good delicacy and harmony.		
Sacred Hill 'Halo' – Hawke's Bay		\$48
Attractive layered aroma with stone fruit supported by floral notes and nuances of hazelnut. The palate is full and very creamy, beautifully textured.		

pinot noir

Wild South – Marlborough	\$10	\$40
An intense bouquet of cinnamon and spice leads into a rich fusion of plums and red cherries and a subtle hint of toasted oak. Velvet tannins flow through with warm earthy notes which give a depth and softness to the wine.		
It Difficultly Roaring Mer – Central Otago		\$52
Tannins rise gracefully out of the mid palate to finish the wine. These are balanced by the wines acidity and fruit, to produce a long fruit driven finish.		
Waipara Hills Equinox – Waipara		\$58
Lifted red fruits, cherry and dark chocolate, with a touch of dried spice, crisp bacon and earthy mushrooms.		
Rockburn – Central Otago		\$66
Rich, creamy, intense fruits and delicate floral tones enhanced by nuances of wild thyme. Silky tannins leading into a long mocha finish.		

syrah/shiraz

Napan Estate 3rd Generation Shiraz – Australia	\$9	\$36
A medium bodied wine displaying concentrated sweet berry fruit with spicy, black pepper notes, well integrated oak and supple tannins on the finish.		
Boundary Vineyards Lake Road Syrah – Gisborne	\$10	\$40
Rich and savoury, with layers of plum, cassis and black pepper flavours and a long spicy finish.		
Tatachilla – McLaren Vale		\$59
Lifted cherry and plum aromas, with a flash of blackberry and violets. The palate is surrounded by cherry, spice flavours framed by silky, concentrated tannins.

Intense in colour, viscous legs cling to the glass. Plum, leather, violets, and sweet berry are manifested on a bed of enriched tannins.

Katnook 'Founders Block' – Coonawarra		\$48
The oak is subdued, with light cedary and chocolaty tones. A medium bodied wine generously flavoured with plum and dark berry fruit flavours.

Packed full of wild blackberry, leather, and spice with a mid palate fullness.		
Anous the Bull – South Australia	\$10	\$40
Ripe black fruits with rich dark chocolate and vanillin smoky oak aromas. Medium to full bodied palate, characterized by a bold savory finish.		
Taylor's Estate – Clare Valley		\$46
It has distinctive blackcurrant and cassis fruit flavours. Subtle oak characters of cedar cigar box and spice are also evident with a well balanced palate.		
Geoff Merrill – Coonawarra/McLaren Vale		\$58
The palate is supple and fleshy with fine firm tannins providing excellent structure. Intense flavour, good length and well balanced wine.

Trinity Hill 'The Trinity' – Hawke's Bay	\$9	\$36
Intense and sweet ripe fruit flavours that lead to a lingering finish of blackberry, chocolate and toasty oak.		
St Hallett Shiraz / Grenache – Barossa Valley	\$9.5	\$38
Vibrant fresh array of red berry fruits and spice with an underlying old world European earthiness. Finishing with soft tannins.		
Morton Estate Black Label Merlot/Cabernet – Hawke's Bay		\$48
Aromas of chocolate and mocha intertwined with berries and currants. The flavours are full of berries, plum and subtle french oak with fine tannins.
